

A MISCELLANY OF SWEET "THINGS"!

MINCEMEAT BROWNIES

6 oz unsalted butter, diced
 5½ oz plain flour
 3½ oz ground almonds, 4 medium eggs,
 5½ oz cranberries, 2oz flaked almonds, 2½oz cherries, roughly chopped
 Icing sugar for dusting

2¼ oz golden caster sugar
 1 tsp baking powder, sifted
 14 oz mincemeat

Method

- 1 Put the sugar and butter in a bowl and beat with a hand whisk until light and fluffy.
- 2 Add the eggs one at a time, mixing after each egg
- 3 Add the flour, baking powder, ground almonds, mincemeat, cranberries, cherries and flaked almonds and mix together
- 4 Pour into a baking tray and smooth over
- 5 Bake for 35mins at 170C, 338 F, Gas Mark 3, until lightly golden and slightly risen.

This will keep in an airtight container for about 5 days. It can also be frozen for up to about 3/4 weeks.



MINCE PIES

Mix 8 oz Plain Flour 6 oz Butter and Grated Rind of an Orange

Mix Pinch Salt, 1 tbs sugar, 1 egg yolk, 2 tsps orange juice, then add to flour mix.

Lightly mix egg white and glaze tarts

Gas mark 6, 200C, 400F for 12 - 15 mins



LEMON CREAM PIE (From Brenda Hargreaves)

8 oz ginger nuts made into crumbs, 3 oz Butter 3 Lemons
 ½ pint of double cream, One tin Condensed Milk full cream

Melt butter in pan, add crumbs, stir and press into the flan tin.
 Whip cream until nearly thick. Stir in Condensed Milk and grated rind of 3 lemons. Stir in juice of the 3 lemons, mix well and pour into the biscuit base and leave to set in fridge.

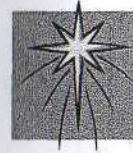
It also freezes well and it can also be made with limes.
